Learning objectives

- Design, implement, debug, and deploy simple full-stack web applications using Node.js and MongoDB for back-end, and React, HTML5 & CSS for front-end, and Git and GitHub for source control and collaboration.

- Live coding (teacher and student led), including student prediction and pair programming.
- Worked examples.
- Individual and small group exercises, and team projects
- Discussions and guidance
- Talks from the industry

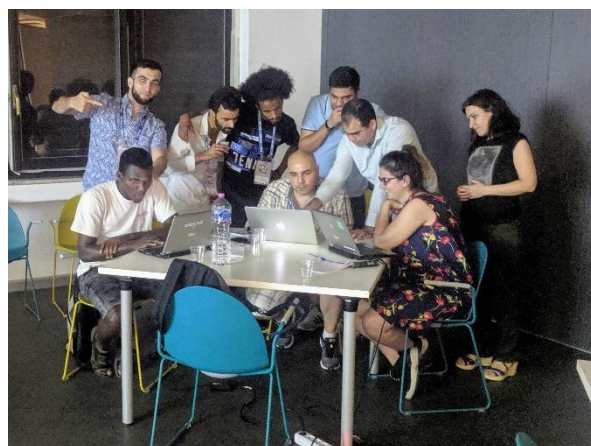
